

Zachow Depot will open in June 2013 !

Dean Proper's replica of the Zachow Depot at Shawano County's Heritage Park is complete.

A scale model display of the buildings in Zachow as they existed in 1949 is being completed this winter and will be featured inside the depot when it opens in June of 2013.

The Depot sits just South of the Old Archive Building at the entrance where tours of the park begin.

Dean Proper conceived this as a tribute and remembrance to his former hometown, which was once a vibrant shipping center for lumber and cattle.

W.C. Zachow sold the C&NW RR 14 acres for a right-o-way; hence, the name Zachow. The C&NW RR built the depot in 1906 from a plan for the Standard No. 3 Depot first put out by C&NW in 1903. This gen-

eral area was previously known as Netley with its post office a mile away from the site that would be platted as Zachow in 1906. The Chicago & North Western railroad line ran from Green Bay to Eland.
